

Hyperostosis

Hyperostosis is an excessive growth of [bone](#). It may lead to exostosis.

The invasion of bone responsible for hyperostosis is a typical phenomenon associated with [en plaque meningiomas](#). Although the sphenoid wing and sphenoidal region are most frequently affected, petrosal involvement is rare and its surgical treatment difficult. Hyperostosis is caused by bone invasion, is responsible for the clinical signs, and prompts the surgeon to use an à la carte drilling that has to be evaluated preoperatively and carried out depending on tumor extension and the treatment goals.

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
