Controversy is a state of prolonged [dispute](#) or [debate](#), usually concerning a matter of conflicting [opinion](#) or point of view.

Opinion articles present the [author's](#) viewpoint on the [interpretation](#), [analysis](#), or [methods](#) used in a particular [study](#). It allows the author to comment on the strength and weakness of a theory or hypothesis. Opinion articles are usually based on constructive criticism and should be backed by [evidence](#) ¹⁾.

Such articles promote [discussion](#) on current issues concerning science. These are also relatively short [articles](#).
